**Position details:** Current Conservation is a not-for-profit quarterly print and online magazine hosted by Dakshin Foundation. A distinguishing factor of CC's work is our visual design. All CC articles go through a detailed art editing process to create rich, perceptive illustrations that amplify the stories that our writers tell and deepen the reader's engagement with the content. The Managing Editor (Art) will be expected to work with the team towards the production of the quarterly magazine and online articles, manage our social media channels, and jointly supervise interns.

### Primary responsibilities:

- Art editing, layout and design of print issues, online articles, and social media posts
- Design and execute social media strategies across multiple platforms
- Plan and execute outreach through online and in-person (when possible) events
- Manage and curate the illustrator database
- Help recruit, supervise and mentor interns
